Fact: WFF has supported over 1000 fistula repair surgeries in Africa to date.



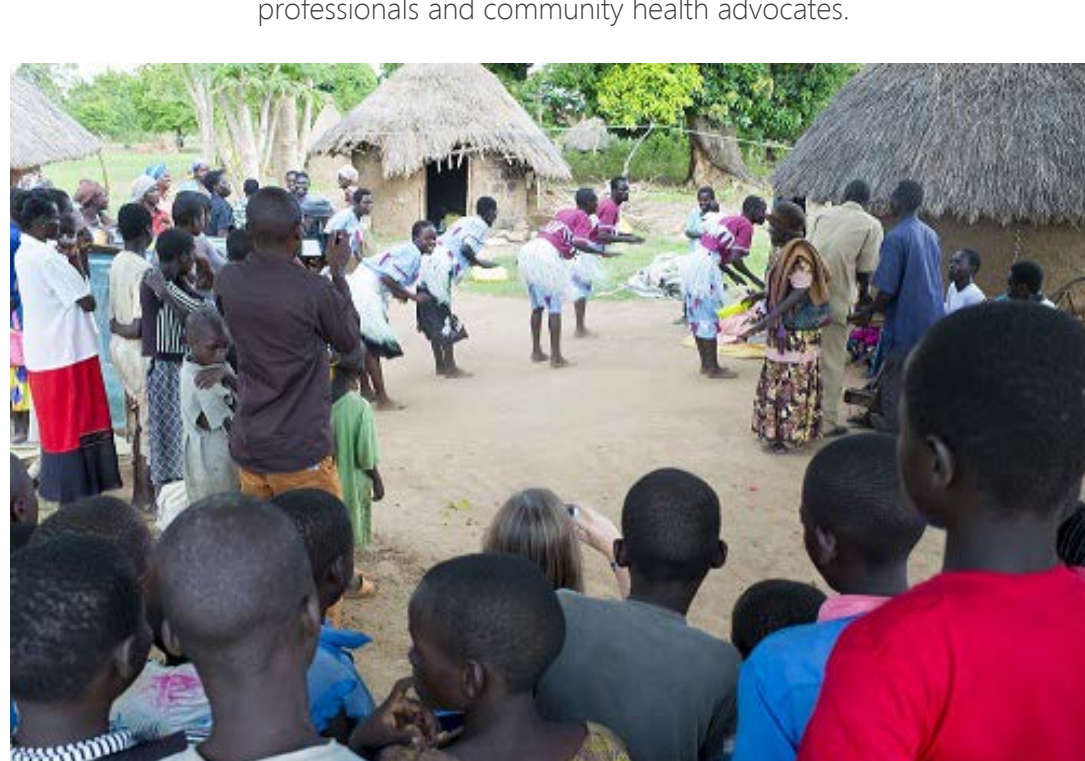
WFF and TERREWODE's collaborative [Reintegration Program](#) provides women free literacy, vocational and advocacy education.
